The first part of the Story--→About Jesus Finding Philip For obviously Philip needed to be found himself...before he..... And it is Jesus who finds him

But here Jesus finds Philip and challenges him with the words→Follow me!

• And surely that's how Jesus works today......

This is different to the story of Andrew and John......

They found Jesus...in the sense.....began to follow Him

We may have been brought up......or come along to church group later on ... we have been talked to about Jesus.....preached at..... loved

But the reason we became a follower......

IS because one day we sensed JESUS speaking into our very heart Saying to us.....Follow me....and like Philip we responded to that

NOW The really exciting thing about Philip's story...

And who looked to others to take the lead....make the decisions

• Yet Jesus sought Him outand in that one phrase is born hope for all Jesus wants everyone on His team

Extrovert and Introvert....The quite achiever and the up front leader
The one with ten talents is just as import as.....the one with one

Jesus values us all with a great depth of love.....and He says to you as He says to me **Follow me.....**And the Greek tense means......Follow me continuously & completely

He has a plan for your today....tomorrow.....and every day of your life

And each day he wants u to commit yourself anew to His plan for u.....

To say to him......I still trust you....And I'm still prepared to follow you wherever
